This color-coding is crucial for ensuring safe installations and maintenance, especially considering that improper wiring can lead to severe hazards. They comply with standardized regulations, such as the National Electrical Code (NEC) in the US. A consumer unit (CU) also known as panel box, breaker box or fuse box is a type of a distribution board (aka electric panel, breaker panel, panelboard or main breaker-box or main service panel) which is used to distribute and fed the electric power to the sub-circuits and final sub-circuits. The color code system used in electrical wiring is a standardized method of identifying wires based on their function, voltage, and insulation type. The American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) and the National Electric Code (NEC) have established specific guidelines for wire color coding.
