

Cable trays can't bend properly when making bends



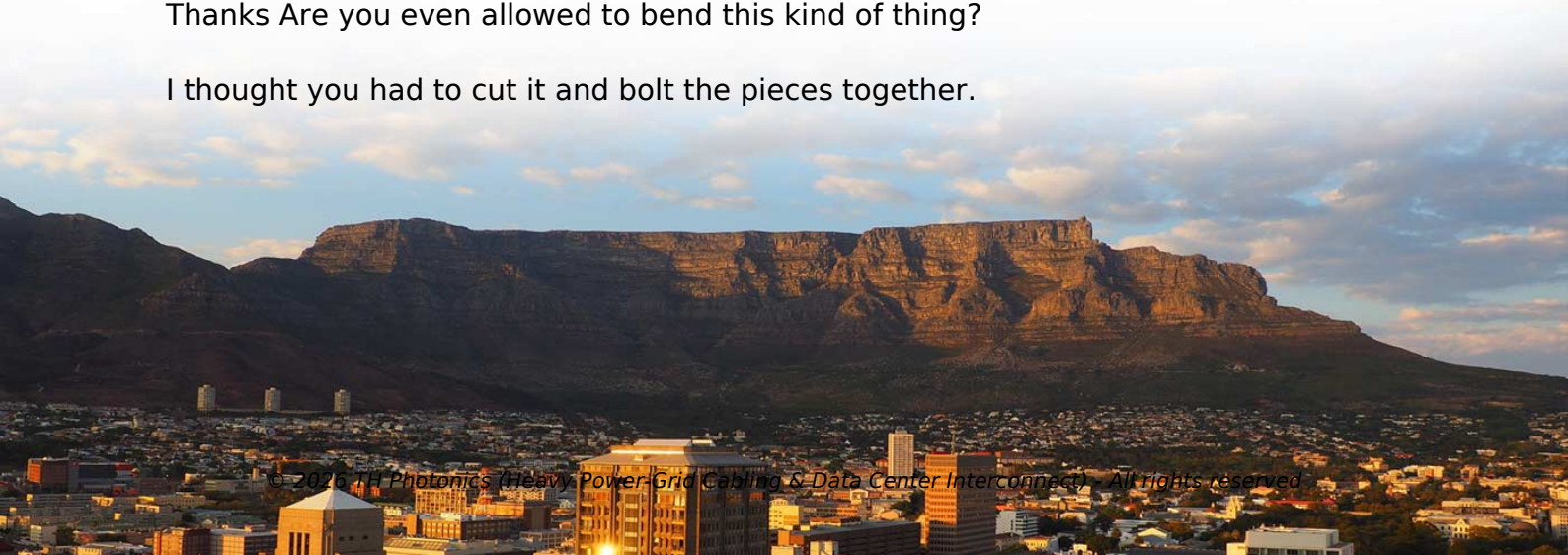
Overview

Sagging and Deflection: Excessive bending occurs when trays carry loads beyond their designed capacity or when support intervals are improperly spaced. This involves a few essential steps to ensure a successful bending process. The first step in preparing the bends, tees, crosses, risers and reducers of wire mesh cable tray can be easily and quickly made live at the project by using a bolt cutter.
