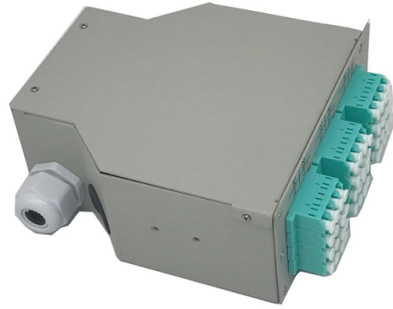


Can cable trays be used without flame retardants



Overview

Only use fireproof trays for flame containment or isolation, not for unrelated functions. If any abnormality is detected. A cable tray failure during a fire can not only damage valuable equipment but also cause downtime that affects business operations. Data centers typically require cable trays. The primary rulebook used in the safe use of cable trays is NEC Article 392. You should consider it as a series of instructions that make the buildings resistant to. Fire prevention and protection systems (FPPS) require cables that meet proper technical standards, especially related to fire-resistant cables (FR) and flame-retardant cables (FRT).
