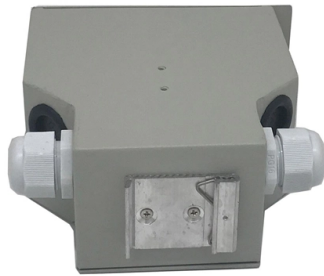


# Can fiber optic cables be used alone
