Segregation of Power and Signal Cables: Power (high-voltage) and signal (low-voltage) cables should be routed separately, using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference. Tray Type and Material Selection Indoor: Painted steel or galvanized trays. Outdoor: Hot-dip galvanized or. The large number of cable support systems run concealed in cable tunnels behind wall and floor coverings. Electrical lines can ignite themselves due to overheating or a short-circuit or they can be set alight by the external influence of fire or heat.
