Overview

Mixing them up drives costs higher, increases loss, and slows your rollout. Available in singlemode and multimode (50/125 and 62. Standard length supplied is 2. Color-coded connectors match wire sizes for proper fit. Yellow nuts typically handle 12-10 AWG wires, while red ones suit 14-12 AWG. Always verify manufacturer specs against your project's load requirements. Leak-tight seals that will withstand high pressure, vibration, vacuum, and temperature changes depend on close.
