

# Do I need to return the original router when decommissioning fiber optic internet



## Overview

Although you're not required to return devices that you've purchased for a one-time charge (such as extra Mesh Extenders), you will be required to return any GFiber devices that were included in your plan for free. You'll receive an email with more information about which devices. When upgrading or changing your GFiber service, you may need to exchange or return equipment. Failure to return equipment can result in. Do I need to. You can do so by bringing the equipment to a FedEx Office Store, shipping it yourself, or by dropping them off at your local GFiber Space.
