Duct fiber optic cables—often called “duct fiber”—are specialized optical cables engineered to be installed within pre-existing ducts (hollow tubes) rather than buried directly in soil or strung from poles. These ducts act as a protective pathway, shielding the fiber from environmental hazards. There are two basic methods of cable installation in a preinstalled duct – Pulling method and Blowing method. The cable installation method is selected based on site conditions and availability of machinery& resources. Mainly manual. Fiber optic cable is usually (but not always) installed in an innerduct that provides mechanical protection for the fiber optic cable.
