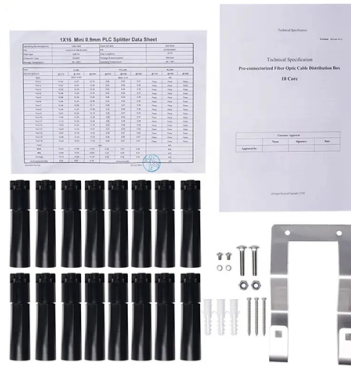


Fiber optic cable exposure
