

Grounding threaded steel for distribution box

To safely ground a metal box, connect an equipment grounding conductor (typically a bare or green insulated wire) from the box to the main electrical panel's ground bus bar. When inspecting the interior of a stainless steel outdoor electrical box distribution box, pay attention to the copper or tin-plated terminals on the base plate or side walls. These locations are usually marked with grounding symbols for easy cable crimping.
