You can install the switch in the following types of cabinets and racks, assuming an external ambient air temperature range of 0 to 104°F (0 to 40°C): If you are selecting an enclosed cabinet, we recommend one of the thermally validated types, either standard perforated or solid-walled with a fan. Network switches, load balancers and routers typically sit at the top and back portion of the rack, away from the cold aisle airflow at the front of the cabinet. This placement makes it difficult for cold air to flow from the front of the rack to the air intakes of the network switch equipment. Even if a power lift is available, heavy equipment should not be placed near the top — taller racks can easily tip over when a server is pulled out of the cabinet on its rails, damaging the equipment and potentially harming personnel. As. At a minimum, adequate cooling requires that you install the switch with the intake side (non port side), facing the cool-air aisle. Rack Specifications

The distance between the outside face of the front mounting rail and the outside face of the back mounting rail should be 23.0 to 30.0 inches (58.4 to 76.2 cm) to allow for rear-bracket installation.
