For loose tube and ribbon cable, the bend radius is specified at 20 times the cable diameter during tension/installation conditions and 10 times during. The maximum installation and storage temperatures specified for each cable in the data sheet must be respected. During the installation process LSZH sheathed cables are more sensitive to cracks and other damage. The information contained in this manual should serve as a guide to proper handling, installing, testing, and for troubleshooting problems with fiber optic cables.
