

How to measure the length of buried optical fiber cables



Overview

Optical fiber length is typically measured using a technique that involves timing how long it takes for light to travel through the fiber. Specifically, the VOLT utilizes a round-robin method to accurately determine the length of optical fiber cables. In extreme cold climates, cables may need to be buried at greater depths where there temperatures are colder and frost penetrates to. Q1: How Deep Should Fiber Optic Cables Be Buried?

A1: Underground fiber optic cables are typically buried 18-36 inches, depending on local regulations, soil type, and site conditions. In urban areas, 12-24 inches is common, while rural or high-traffic zones may require 24-48 inches to provide. These length testers use a “round-robin” method of measuring fiber length. Fiber optic cable should not be coiled in a continuous direction except for lengths of 30 meters (100 ft) or less. The preferred sized for the “figure-eight” is about 4.5 meters (15 ft) in length with each loop 1.5
