In situations where there's a shortage of Ethernet ports, some users may insert Ethernet port modules into optical ports to connect with copper cables for data transmission. This design enables end-to-end optical signal transmission, avoiding the conversion between electrical and optical signals at the switch port level. Optical ports include SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP+, and QSFP28. GBIC can be hot-swapped in design. RJ45 ports serve access-layer copper connections; SFP/SFP+ ports enable flexible 1G/10G uplinks; SFP28 delivers 25G for modern data centers; QSFP+ and QSFP28 support high-density 40G/100G spine-leaf.
