

Method for bending back electrical wires in household distribution boxes



Overview

How to use an EMT conduit bender to bend conduit 90 degrees, bend an offset, bend back to back 90 degree bends, bend a 3 point saddle bend, and how to straighten a bend. Provided by Elliott Electric Supply, distributor of EMT benders, EMT conduit, and other electrical supplies. Do you all have an guidance on how to properly manage the wiring inside a box. I try to route the conductors in a circle around the edges of the box rather than fold them and push them in. It usually leaves enough space in the center of the box for the switch/receptacle and sometimes fits better. Ideally, wire groups are installed in layers and wires are bent at right angles to buses or breakers. Label short sheathing sections (slugs) to indicate which circuits wires serve. Labeling cables at outlets is important so that when it comes time to attach wires to devices, you'll always know. Is there a trick to shoving the wires back into the box?

I do know about box sizes and how many wires can fit into what size, but it's tough getting those things back into the box after hooking them up. My over-the-sink light box has two 12/3s and a 12/2 coming into it and it is really hard to get.
