Problems within a fiber link can occur due to a wide variety of reasons. A very common problem is that a connector is not fully engaged - often hard to notice in a crowded patch panel. Moreover, because fibre fusion splicers operate under very fine tolerances, even minor contamination or calibration errors can significantly affect splice quality.
