There are several reasons for “no light” issues: incompatible SFP module, incorrect connection, SFP module not powered on, or bad SFP. Incompatible SFP: Please check the compatibility of your optical transceiver with your equipment. Or it could be caused by the quality of the connector itself, such as poor end-face geometry that doesn't pass the parameters defined by IEC PAS 61755-3 standards, including angle of the polish, fiber height, radius of curvature or apex offset.
