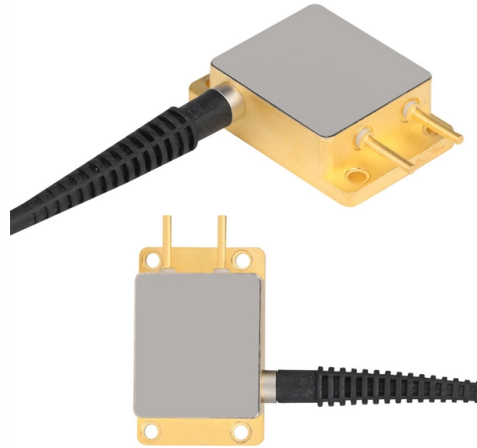


The pigtail inside the box

A pigtail is a simple wiring technique used when installing electrical outlets, switches, or other devices inside a junction box. This method involves connecting the circuit's main wires to a short jumper wire, or pigtail, which then connects to the terminal of the device. This keeps the circuit intact even if the outlet is removed or fails, improves connection reliability, and is required by code in. The pigtail is your designated representative, bundling everyone's IDs (or electricity, in this case) and getting it where it needs to go.
