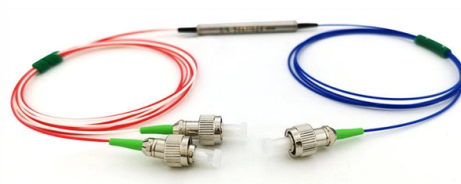


Vertical cabling fiber optic cable
