

# West Africa Optical Cable Construction



## Overview

Maroc Telecom has invested a substantial sum of 150 million euros in the development of a state-of-the-art fiber optic submarine cable known as “West Africa.” This cutting-edge infrastructure was unveiled during the Gitex Africa 2023 event held in Marrakech from May 31 to June 2. While submarine communications cables are used to connect countries and continents to the Internet, terrestrial fibre optic cables are used to extend this connectivity to landlocked countries or to urban centers within a country. Itissalat Al Maghrib (Maroc Telecom) has invested 150 million euros in the construction of a new submarine fibre optic cable. 2Africa is a landmark subsea cable system that sets a new standard for global connectivity. We are Africa's leading provider of interconnected, carrier-scale digital. The West Africa Cable System (WACS) is a 14530km submarine cable system connecting 15 countries, starting from South Africa and ending in London. The WACS consists of four fibre pairs. It was initially designed with 128 wavelengths per fiber pair, running at 10 Gbps per wavelength, and initial.
